Thank you for your ticket purchase of a public tour on the Wells Petroglyph Preserve. Your tour fee will help to support our archaeological recording and education programs.

What to Bring-

Plenty of water, sun screen, a hat and sturdy footwear for hiking on loose gravel and steep terrain. Optionally, walking sticks, binoculars and polarized sunglasses can all be very helpful.

Where to Go-

Open and download the Map to the Wells Petroglyph Preserve attachment above. The location of the preserve is protected, there is no signage, and Google maps and GPS will not properly direct you. The directions on this map will :) Take time to download your map with good reception or a wi-fi connection. Your docent will meet you in the parking lot of the Preserve.

What to Know -

Facilities on the preserve are limited to one outhouse. This outhouse is located a short walk from the parking and meeting area. If time allows, we recommend using a facility at another location before the start of the tour. All tours are docent led, and there are no self-guided options available. Please note that children under 10 are not allowed, and dogs are not allowed except as service animals. Ticket sales are non-refundable. Tours are occasionally cancelled for reasons such as safety, weather, trail conditions, illness or other emergency needs. In the event of such a cancellation, you will be notified by MPPP staff no later than 7:30 am the day of the tour. We ask that you rebook your tour within two weeks. After that time, please consider your fee a donation to the MPPP - we thank you!

Plan your Trip -

Etiquette - The Wells Petroglyph Preserve is private property. It is the only section of Mesa Prieta that is legally protected. Our visitors help us ensure that our impact on this incredible place is both minimal and respectful. We ask our visitors to strictly follow these guidelines.

1. Stay on trail and stay with your guide. The landscape of Mesa Prieta is an escarpment that has been stripped of its natural vegetation. Erosion is one of the most imminent threats to preservation. Every footstep outside of established trails speeds erosion by shifting the delicate cryptobiotic soil.
2. Do not touch the petroglyphs. Oils from your fingers interfere with advanced dating techniques. For this reason along with maintaining proper respect for the place, we ask you not to touch the petroglyphs. Walking sticks will create a scratch on the surface of the panel as well. Be careful of pointing them too close to a panel.
